Is your organisation ready for Workplace Fairness Legislation?

Find out what you can start doing to prepare your organisation for the **upcoming Workplace Fairness legislation**.

With the **Tripartite Guidelines on Fair Employment Practices (TGFEP)** being retained and enhanced to work in concert with legislation, it presents a clear opportunity now for business and human resources (HR) leaders to take stock and know where your organisation stands in terms of its fair employment practices in adherence with the prevailing TGFEP.

As a start, employers need to do the following:

1. Review your organisation's recruitment practices and put in place policies and procedures.

2. Put in place clear grievance handling processes (GHP) to resolve grievances and disputes at the workplaces.

Review the insights and recommendations provided to identify where your organisation can close the gaps and create a truly conducive workplace.

2. Refer to the list of practices found in the <u>Tripartite Standards</u> on **Recruitment Practices** and **Grievance Handling** as an additional guide in the implementation of fair employment practices.
